ORDER

DEFENDANT/PETITIONER OBLIGOR/OBLIGEE

WHEREAS, the above-named Obligor has been ordered to provide health insurance coverage for the child(ren) who are the subject of a child support order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that:

1. Obligor shall designate (list full names and birth dates of children)

\_\_\_\_\_ as dependents eligible for health insurance coverage in the group health insurance policy offered (i) by Obligor's Employer or (ii) through the group plan available to Obligor, within thirty (30) days from the date of this order.

2. Obligor shall, NO LATER than 30 days after the issuance of this order, furnish written proof to the Miami County Child Support Enforcement Agency that the required health insurance has been obtained.

3. Obligor shall supply Obligee with (i) insurance forms necessary to receive payment, reimbursement, or other benefits, (ii) with necessary insurance cards, and (iii) with all information available to Obligor regarding benefits, limitations, and exclusions of the health insurance coverage.

4. The Obligor shall be responsible for the costs of uninsured extraordinary medical, dental, optical or psychological expenses, including co-payments and deductibles under the health insurance plan for the children as set forth in the Miami County Common Pleas Court Standard Order of Health Care Needs For Dependent Children and Additional Order of Health Care Needs For Dependent Children unless otherwise ordered by separate judgment entry of the Court. The Obligee shall be responsible for uninsured ordinary and necessary medical, dental and optical expenses including co-payments and deductibles as set forth on the Miami County Common Pleas Court Standard Order of Health Care Needs For Dependent Children and Additional Order of Health Care Needs For Dependent Children unless otherwise ordered by the Court.

5. Obligor shall be liable to Obligee for any medical expenses incurred for the children as a result of Obligor's failure to comply with the order herein.

6. The Insurer of the Obligor shall, upon the filing of the required insurance or claims forms, reimburse directly to the parent which is designated to receive reimbursement in the above order, the out-of-pocket expenses paid by the Obligor or Obligee under the policy on behalf of the insured children. The Insurer shall comply with this order regardless of the residence of the minor children.

7. The Insurer may continue making payments for medical, optical, hospital, dental, or prescription services directly to any health care provider in accordance with the applicable health insurance of health care policy contract or plan.

8. Nothing in this Order shall be construed to require the Insurer to accept enrollment for any child who does not meet the underwriting standards of the health insurance or health care policy, contract or plan for which the application is made.

9. The Employer shall, upon written Order of this Court, be required to enroll the Obligor in any available health care coverage provided for the children and, if the application is accepted, to deduct any additional amount from the Obligor's earnings necessary to pay the cost of said coverage. The Employer shall submit to the Insurer a copy of the Court's Order requiring the Obligor's enrollment of the children.

10. The Employer shall release to the Obligee or the Miami County Child Support Enforcement Agency, upon written notice, any necessary information related to the health insurance of the Obligor.

11. The Insurance company, Employer, Obligor and Obligee shall comply with R.C. 3119 and with the Court's Order herein.

12. The Employer shall notify the Miami County Child Support Enforcement Agency of any change in or termination for the Obligor's health insurance coverage maintained pursuant to R.C. 3119.

13. Whoever violates an Order issued under R.C. 3119 may be punished as and for Contempt under R.C. 2705.
